Final Transition Information:

- Students should arrive to the academy **on Monday 8th July** no later than **8:30am** in their primary school uniform. Students will be directed down the main path and into the Main School Hall for a welcome assembly.
- Following Monday, students should arrive for **8.25/8:30am for the rest of the week** and will go to their year group break area, outside of the dining hall. Students will meet their 'buddies' there, before being taken to their first lesson each day. If there is inclement weather, students will be housed in the Main School Hall.
- On **Wednesday 10th July**, please send students to the academy in their primary PE kit, which they will be in for the day. Students will be taking part in a session of sport ran by our PE Department. They can bring additional water if needed, no fizzy drinks please. We also advise that students have applied suncream if the weather is as warm as it has been in recent weeks as these sessions will be taking place outside.
- Students will leave the academy each day at **3:00pm** with the other year groups in attendance, aside from Friday which will be a slightly earlier finish as we aim to get students off-site by 2:45pm following a final celebration assembly.
- Students will be **placed into their tutor and teaching groups** (for September) and have the chance to spend time with their peers, experiencing a range of lessons. This will be as close to a 'real' timetable that they can expect to follow in September.
- Students need to ensure they have a packed lunch with them for Monday to Thursday. On **Friday 12th July** which is their last day of transition, during tutor time, all students will receive a free lunchtime voucher for a main-meal. Any student who is entitled to a **free school meal** will be able to collect a grab bag for lunch each day that they are at the academy.
- Aside from a packed lunch, they will need to bring a pencil case with a pen/pencil; their usual pencil case will be fine. All other equipment/resources will be provided within the activities that they complete.
